

I come to the Garden Alone

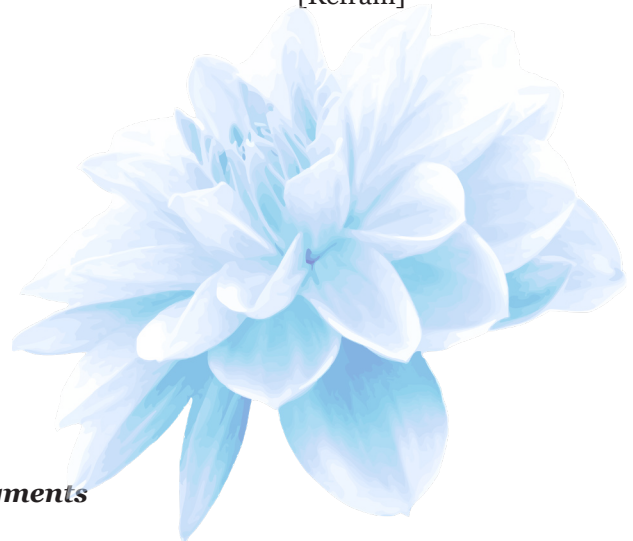
I come to the garden alone
