How Great Thou Art

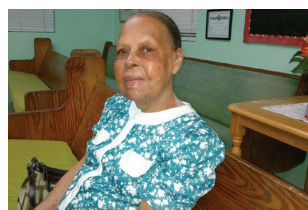
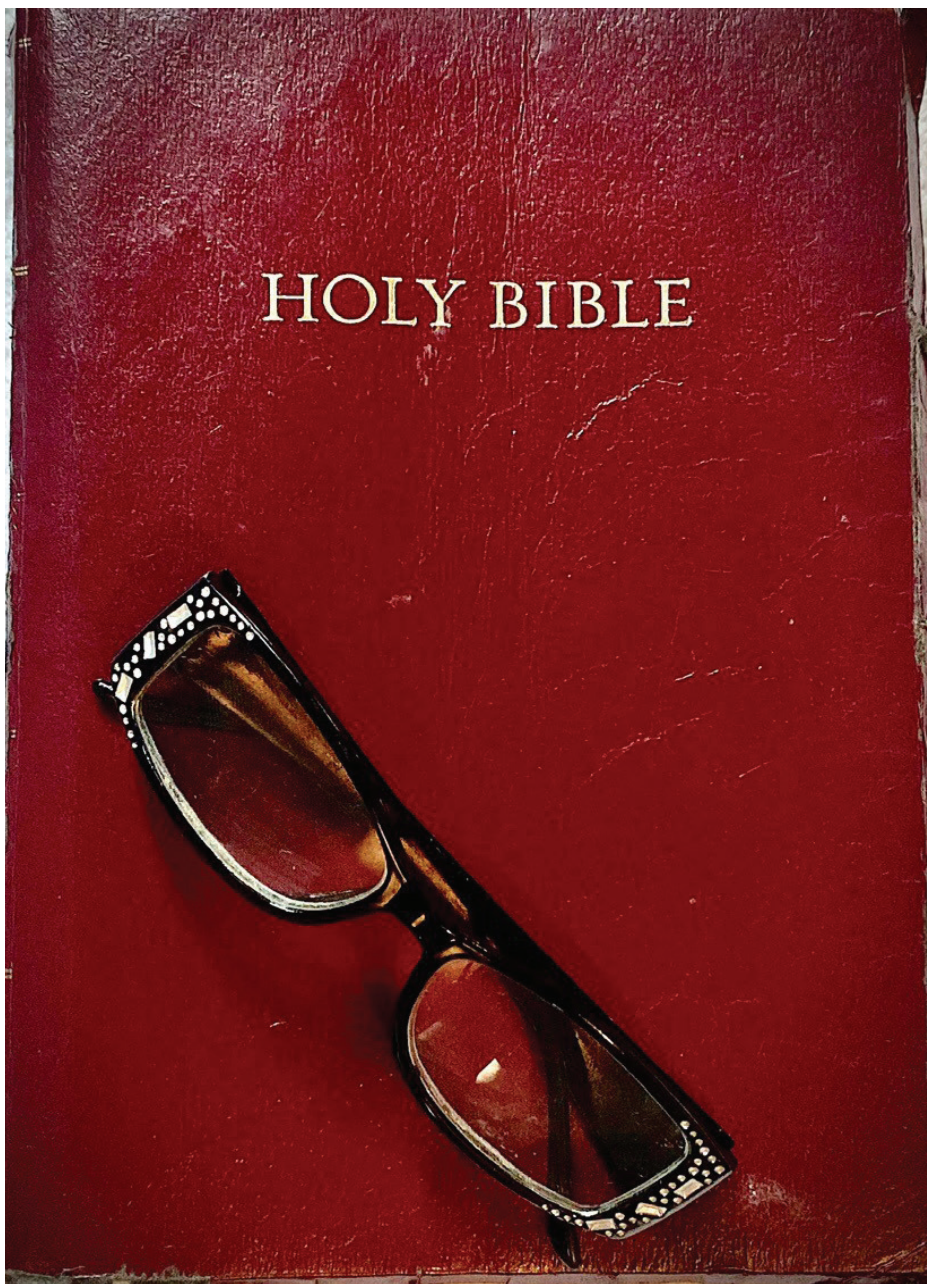
O Lord my God! When I in awesome wonder,
