Jim was born in Pittsfield, Massachusetts. He attended schools in Lanesboro until the family moved to St. Petersburg, Florida when he was 12. He graduated from Gibbs High School and St. Petersburg Junior College.

Jim loved to read. At 3 and 4 years old he learned the phonetic sounds and the names of letters. He started to read before he went to Kindergarten. Weeks before he started school, he told me that he would not be able to attend because he didn't know "everything".

He was so relieved to find out that if he knew "everything" he didn't need to go to school!

Jim was well rounded growing up. He enjoyed building with Legos, riding bikes, playing sports, digging in the sand box and swimming.

He was focused. As a child, when given a plate of food containing a meat, vegetable and potatoes, he would eat all of one type of food before even tasting the next. He applied this trait throughout his life whether it was playing, studying, or working.

In his teens, Jim started his career parttime working as a bag boy in a grocery store.

That led him to moving to Grand Cayman in April 1997 to work at Foster's where, he told his family, he lived and worked in paradise.
