She was a very bright and cheerful child and attended Savannah Primary School, the Middle School and John Gray High School from which she graduated in 1987.

December 4th 2015, when her granddaughter Nathalie Reynolds was born she was so happy and couldn't wait to tell people that she was now a grandmother. She took Nattie as her own and loved her dearly.

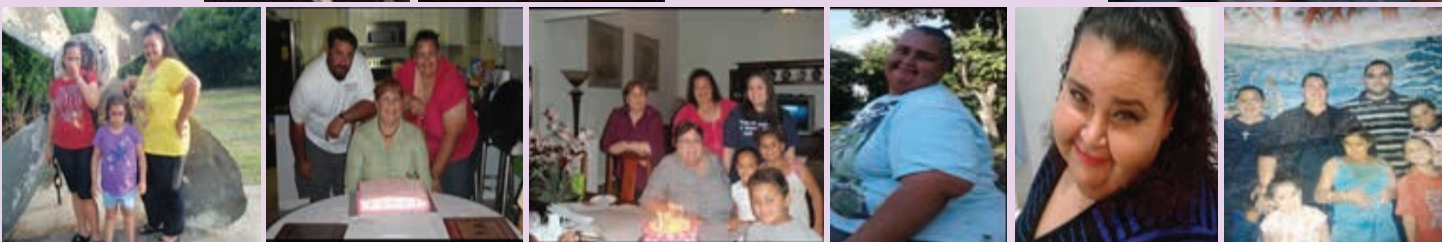
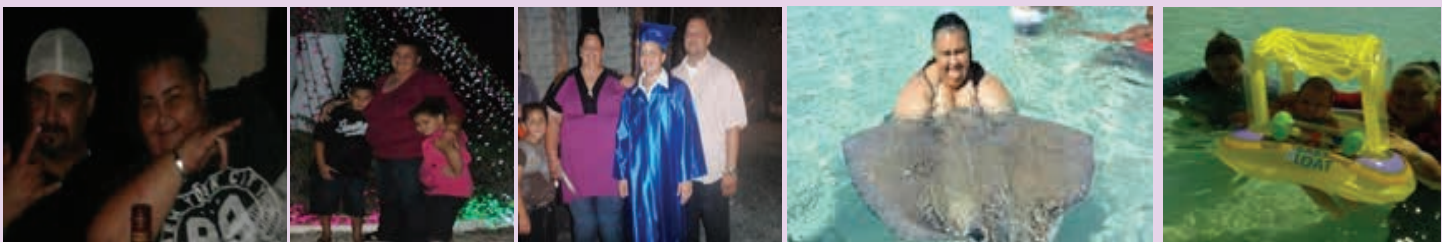

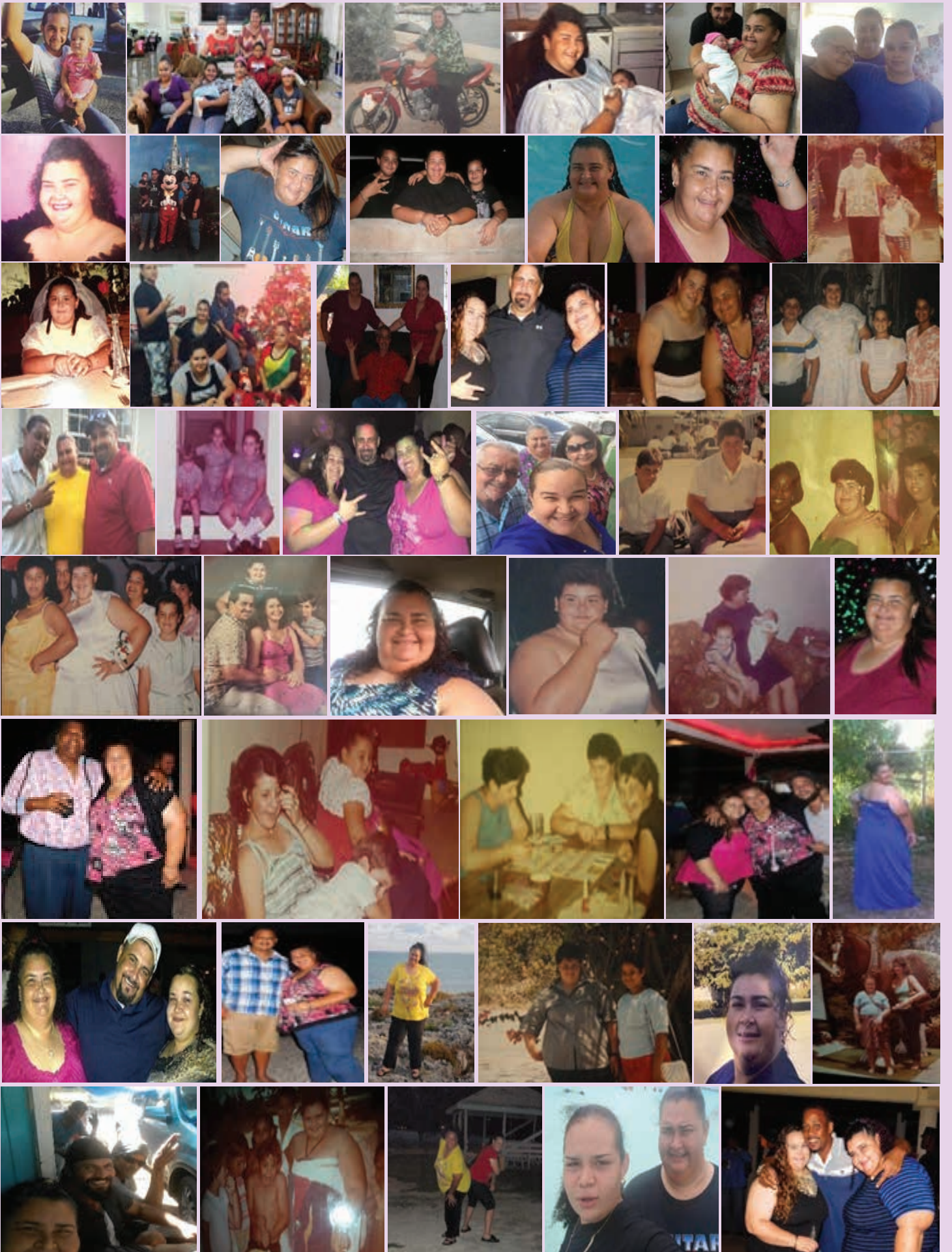
