#### The Life Story of CHANNAH LAKISHA CONNOR

Channah Lakisha Connor, also known to her family as Chan Chan, Punkas and Channah Banana, was born on the afternoon of Thursday, 1 February 2001 in Cayman Brac, Cayman Islands to Loretta Grizzel and Channing Connor.

Channah primarily grew up in her mother's home but lived, along with her siblings Tishel Watler and Jordan Grizzel, for a time in her maternal Grandmother Alex Grizzel's house in The Rock, Cayman Brac. She also regularly spent time with her father and her paternal Grandmother Shirleymae Connor in Watering Place, Cayman Brac. There were always many cousins and friends around for Channah to study, play and of course get into mischief with.

Channah completed her primary education at West End Primary School from 2005-2012. Part of her secondary education was completed at the Layman E. Scott Sr. High School from 2012-2015. She relocated from Cayman Brac to Grand Cayman to live with her mother and sister Tishel in the summer of 2015, and continued her secondary education at the Clifton Hunter High School from 2015-2017. From 2017-2018 she completed her final year of secondary education at the Cayman Islands Further Education Centre (CIFEC) and graduated in June 2018.

During the years of her secondary education in Cayman Brac, she was a member of the debate team, placing first in the competition against the other high schools in the country. Before relocating to Grand Cayman she also entered the Claudette Upton Speech Competition twice, placing 2nd in 2012 and 3rd in 2013. While a student at the Clifton Hunter High School and CIFEC in Grand Cayman, she was a member of the Clifton Hunter High School Flight Camp and a prefect student member. She served as the president of the Alpha Leo Club from 2016-2017, and served as a member of the Lions Club until 2019. In 2016 she received the 'Proud of Them' award for community service, and had her name, photo and school details posted on a street side billboard in Frank Sound.

During her short life Channah attended church services at the Stake Bay Baptist Church, the Crossroad United Baptist Church and the Bethel Baptish Church. She especially enjoyed attending the various churches' Vacation Bible Schools and other youth programmes. As a child she was led to know Christ and accepted Him as her personal Saviour on Friday March 19th 2010 by Mrs. Bobbi Turner during one of Pastor Russell Turner's weekly "Pre-Teens" church meetings. Her family will eternally be grateful for Mrs. Turner's love and kindness to Channah.

Channah's immediate family loved to get together often and what they loved doing most together was laugh. She was the main comedian of her family and enjoyed teaming up with her siblings to trick and prank their mom, all for the purpose of laughing together. She enjoyed teaching her niece and nephews to do many funny and silly things before sending them back off to their parents to showcase what they just learned from their Auntie Chan. Christmas was Channah's favourite time of year to gather with her mom and siblings, which they mostly did at her sister Tishel's home over the past decade. Channah was normally in charge of the games and family activities. She strategically coordinated these so that it always resulted in everyone laughing. She spearheaded a lot of the birthday plans and other family gatherings, and truly enjoyed gift giving.

Channah spent her childhood years playing with her siblings, cousins and friends on the beach, exploring along the ironshore of The Rock and Watering Place and in the yards of her mother and grandmothers. She spent many happy hours playing video games with her siblings, playing with her dolls and cuddling with her pets. Not only did she enjoy playing video games as a child, but in recent years she enjoyed playing them with her niece and nephews. Her favourite colours were black, silver and red and she loved all animals but her favourites were cats. She worked in customer service at various businesses where she was noted in references for being a customer service champion with a pleasant personality, never late nor absent and quite the reliable worker. In recent years she developed an amazing skill in applying makeup to herself and her friends and family. She made plans to start cosmetology classes in June, 2023 after receiving encouragement from her mother and other family and friends who saw that her makeup skills were outstanding. Sadly, she did not get to pursue those dreams as she suddenly passed away under tragic circumstances on Sunday, 30 April 2023 at approximately 1:30am.

During her short life Channah's kind and loving personality resulted in her acquiring a significant amount of friends. Her closest friend Qia Whittaker contributed immensely to her happiness in life and shares in her family's grief. Her Grandmother Alex considered Channah to be more a daughter rather than her granddaughter due to the significant amount of time she spent in her house in her early childhood. She bravely but painfully mourns the passing of her beautiful granddaughter along with Loretta.



May her soul now Rest in Peace.

































































































































































