Obituary for the late Diety Grayburn Jackson Johnson

Diety Grayburn Jackson Johnson of Guanaja, Honduras was born to the late Victoria De Jackson and Allen Jackson. He had a happy childhood surrounded by 7 siblings (4 brothers and 3 sisters). He attended the local school as did everyone during that time.

Around 1965 Grayburn met a young girl by the name of Rita A. Hyde Moore from Mangrove Bight Guanaja. Over the next 57 years they raised their blended family of 9 children (6 girls & 3 boys). When Grayburn met Rita, she had already had three children, Aurora, Ezone & Johnnie, they started their lives together living on the key in the Bay Islands then moving to Sand Bay. In the early eighties they moved their family to Savannah Bight Guanaja. In Dec 1967 Rita & Grayburn were blessed with their first child a baby girl Ethlyn, in Sept 1970 their 2nd child Donna, April 1972 their 3rd daughter Kim, finally in June 1975 they had their first son Dyke, in Jan 1985 their 2nd son Lamar and in June 1986 Rita gave birth to her last daughter Janneth. On May 16, 1998, Rita at the age of 53 & Grayburn 52 tied the knot at their house in Savannah Bight Guanaja in the presents of their family & friends.

Over the course of their life, they have split their time living/working between Guanaja, Bay Islands Honduras & the Cayman Islands as Grayburn's family is original from East End Grand Cayman.

Grayburn spent his life caring fondly for his children and grandchildren and enjoyed the time spent with his great grandchildren. He was a captain and a talented carpenter; you name it, and he could build it. He and his brother Corvin were well known for building beautiful homes, one of which was his own in Savannah Bight Guanaja. It was his absolute joy to be helpful within his family and relished any and every opportunity to be kind to those in need. Throughout his life he would go out of his way to care for many, family or not, this was well known and appreciated by his community. Though life was not always easy, He managed to provide for his family by being the best at what he did, alongside his wife they found ways to make ends meet, all the while remaining generous and of dutiful service.

From 2018 to 2021 Grayburn spent most of his time living in the Cayman Islands, after he returned to the Cayman Island to get better assistance with his health issues, over the next few years he was blessed with good and bad days. On June 28th, 2023, after a prolonged period of illness he passed away at home.

He is preceded in death by his parents; Victoria De Jackson and Allen Jackson, his wife Rita Amed Jackson Hyde, his daughter Aurora Hydes & his brother's Corvin Jackson and Warren Jackson.
