A member of the Professional Womens Club and the Cayman Islands Seafarers Association.

Privileged to get to sail with her husband on the S.S. Cavala on multiple occasions.

Travelled to many parts of the U.S., many parts of Canada, England, Scotland, the British Virgin Islands and Honduras.

A cancer survivor for the past 7 years and blessed to have been given a long life. To have lived the changes in this world that she got to see and things she got to do.

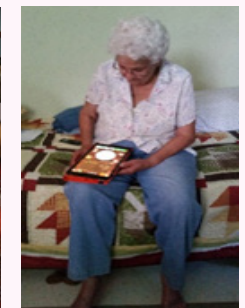
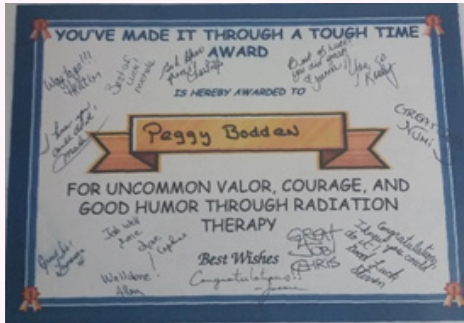
