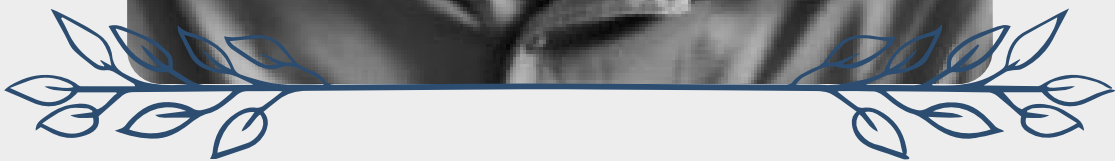
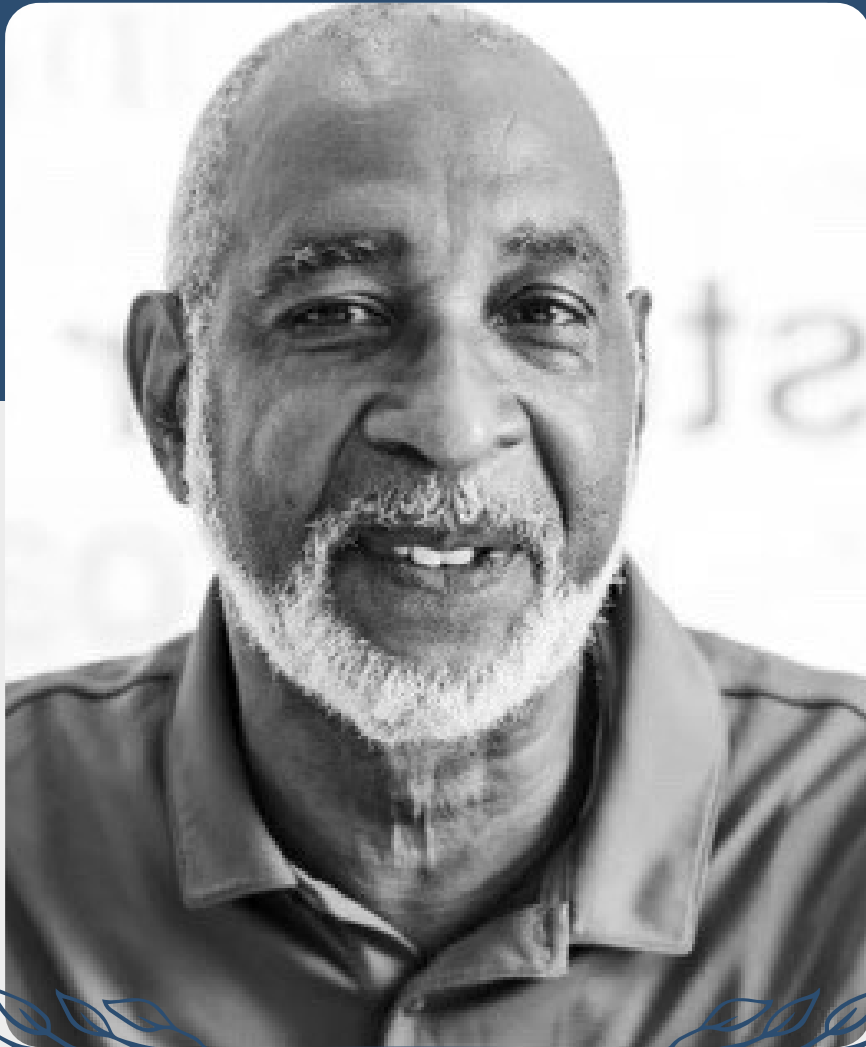

Obituary



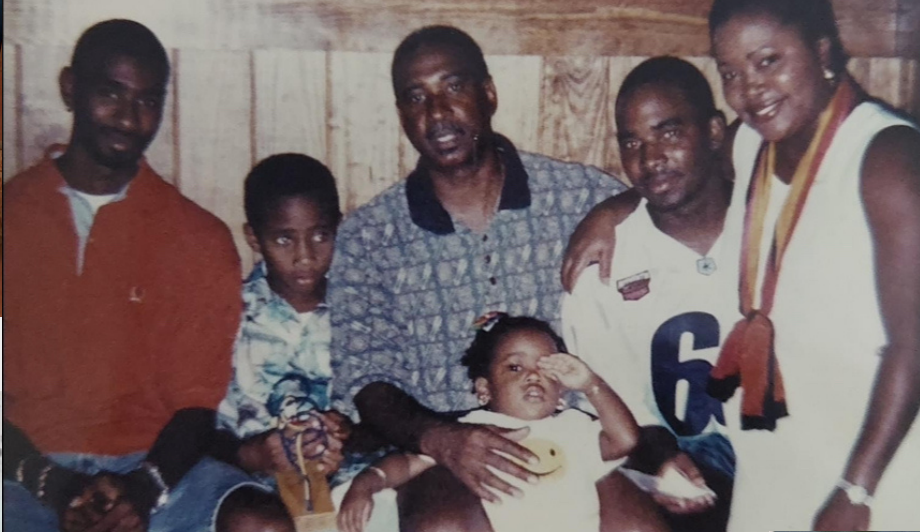
As we look back over time
