Later, as a toddler he was taken to Jamaica, where he remained with his dad's family until the age of 12 when he returned to his parents. He started middle school and then onwards to Cayman Islands High School. Cliff graduated at the age of 16 from high school.

He commenced employment at Don Fosters Dive, where he trained and certified as an open water scuba diver. After a few years he started employment at the Hyatt hotel for another number of years. He met his former wife Sonia at the age of 25 and they got married when he was 27 yrs old and of that union, came 1 son D'Angelo Smith. This union continued through raising their son. During his marriage, Cliff worked at Phillips Electrical for a number of years.

In 2003, after the passing of his father, Cliff's life faced many hardships, including major health issues, including a severe back injury which prejudiced his ability to maintain gainful employment. His quality of life continued to deteriorate, but worsened with the passing of his beloved mother in 2020. Sadly, Cliff finally succumbed to his many medical morbidities, where he passed suddenly on Saturday March 23, 2024.
