Emily grew up in Cayman Brac, where she attended primary school. Her love for cooking began in her mother's kitchen, a passion that would shape her life. In the late 1970s, she moved to Little Cayman in search of work, finding a home at the Southern Cross Club. From 1981 to 2012, she held various roles, including cook, housekeeper, and all-rounder, embodying the true spirit of "Cayman Kind." Emily was not only a dedicated employee but also a tourism ambassador for Little Cayman. She forged close bonds with fellow Cayman Brackers, like Merilda Massias, with whom she worked tirelessly to restore the resort after Hurricane Paloma in 2008.

In 1990, Emily briefly lived in Grand Cayman, where she operated Country & Western Restaurant on a lease and worked as a chef at Apollo 11. However, her heart remained in Little Cayman, and she returned to work at the Central Caribbean Marine Institute, where she served as a cook until her retirement in December 2023. Known for her fried chicken and key-lime pie, Emily was a vital member of the institute and was deeply loved by all who knew her.

Emily was a woman of many talents, continuing to cook from her own kitchen and selling her dishes to local residents. Her love for cooking was matched only by her love for her family. She welcomed her beautiful daughter Tianne on November 27, 1990 and married Victor Manuel Lopez Jr. on September 27, 2004. Emily was a proud grandmother to Cianna and Pecena, who brought immense joy to her life.

A fighter throughout her life, Emily survived a brain aneurysm in 2002 and was diagnosed with cancer in 2021, yet she remained strong and courageous. She was baptized into the Adventist Church two years ago, reaffirming her faith.

Emily's vibrant personality, her love for country music, fishing, and her family, will be fondly remembered by all. Her quirky sayings, "boi you is laughable" and "you fool you know," brought laughter and joy to those around her.

Emily is survived by her loving husband, Victor Jr.; daughter, Tianne; granddaughters, Cianna & Pecena; Father-in-law, Victor Sr.; brothers; Elwood & Dario Bodden, Woodley Christian. Sisters-in-law Anne & Editha, Sonia C, Mirian, Zoila, Esperanza, Isabel, Sonia L & Nicia; Brothers-in-law Mario & Carlos. She was predeceased by her parents & siblings Linton.
