Shortly after her birth, her parents, Robert and Cleta Ebanks, returned to Grand Cayman with their beautiful daughter. She was later joined by two younger brothers, Aubrey and Daniel, completing their loving family.

Jan's educational journey began at the Truth for Youth School and continued at the Cayman Islands High School, where she graduated in 1973. She later pursued her tertiary studies at the International College of the Cayman Islands, equipping herself for a fulfilling life ahead. Growing up on Walkers Road and North Sound Road, and later in the family home on Canal Lane Crewe Road, Jan enjoyed a lively childhood filled with humor and playful antics alongside her brothers, cousins, and friends.

Jan took pride in her appearance, always ensuring her nails and hair were impeccably styled. Her love for fashion was evident in her impressive collection of name-brand handbags, each perfectly suited for any occasion.

Throughout her life, Jan suffered various health challenges which eventually led to the amputation of her leg in 1993. Although she was wheelchair bound that didn't prevent her from continuing to enjoy life to the fullest. One would even think it made her even more determined to succeed and triumph over adversity. Jan thrived on the connections she made with people from all walks of life. In fact, because of her caring nature and the way she faced challenges head on, she was often called upon to comfort others who themselves were experiencing medical challenges and amputations. She was able to be a source of comfort and beacon of hope to so many persons in this community.

In 1995, Jan married her longtime friend Tony Campbell and although they later separated they remained friends up until her passing.

Jan's career began at Touche Ross & Co. (now Deloitte & Touche) and she then briefly ventured into entrepreneurship before finding her true calling at Car City Ltd. and the Foster Group of Companies, starting on July 12 1996. Over her remarkable 28 plus year tenure, Jan forged deep connections with her coworkers, who became more like family. Her unwavering dedication and work ethic shone brightly, proving that her mobility challenges would never impede her commitment to excellence. She can rest assured knowing that she did not leave an unfinished task.

Family was everything to Jan. She relished family reunions, birthday celebrations, Easter camping trips and sporting events. She could be found front and center cheering her family on. She loved life and never missed an opportunity to celebrate with her family.

Sadly, Jan unexpectedly departed her earthly home on Monday March 24 2025 surrounded by her loving family. She is now reunited in glory with her precious mother Cleta and others dear to her heart.

Left to mourn her passing are her heartbroken and devoted father Robert; brothers Aubrey and Daniel; sisters in law Brenda and Alina; nieces Jenny and Jessie; special cousins Robin and Jean; caregiver/driver Kay; so many cherished coworkers at Car City Ltd. and Foster Group of Companies along with a multitude of relatives and friends.
