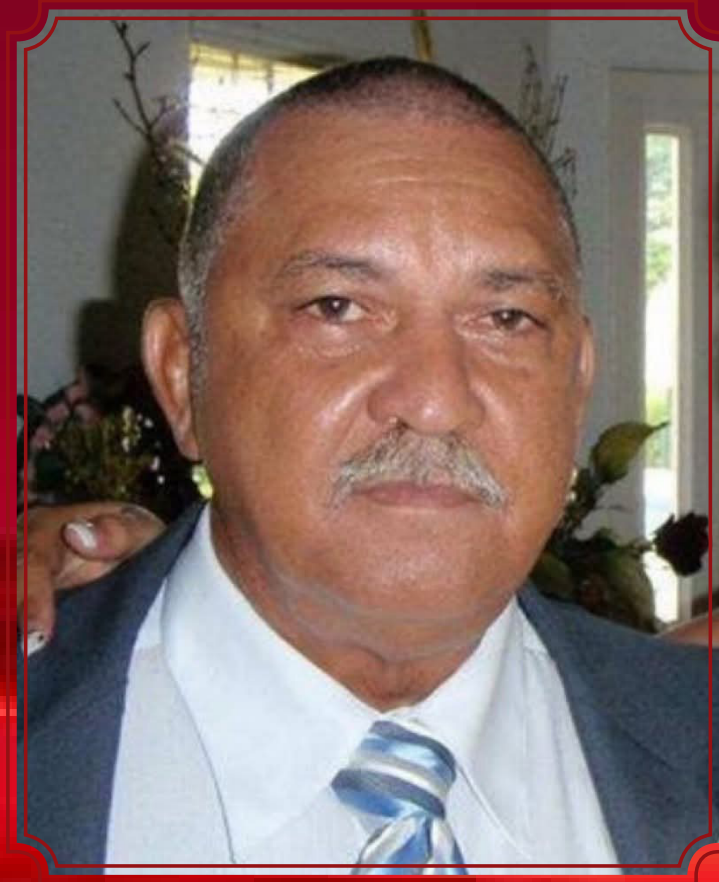

He started to save his money and when he turned 15 years old, he went out to sea, and sailed with the National Bulk Carriers for ten and a half years.

Halsey traveled all over the world, it was his earnest desire to become a captain but one day they encountered very bad weather and this changed his mind completely, he returned home and married Ms. TwylaMae Levi, and they had two sons, Raul and John.

That marriage ended and later on he had two daughters, Alice and Deidra Andrews.

Later on he met his wife Martha L. Andrews whom he called ' his Cayman Brac Beauty ' who is his surviving wife.

He worked in Cayman Brac and Little Cayman as an electrician for 17 years.

He moved back to Grand Cayman in 2001 and he resided and worked here until his passing.

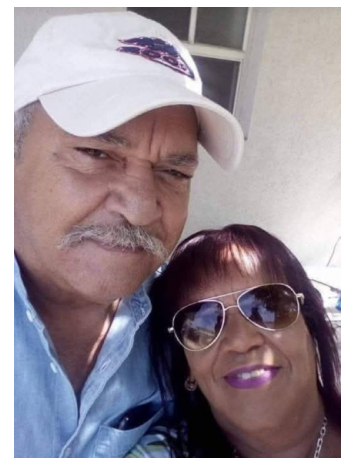
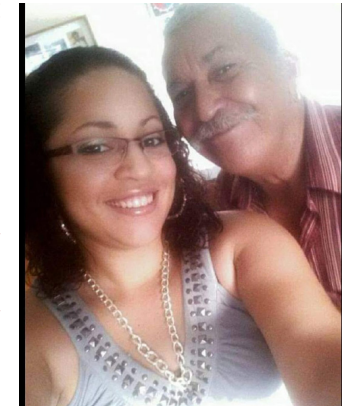
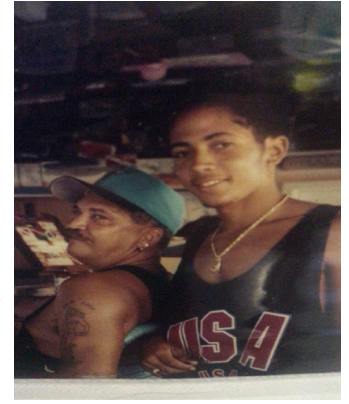
He was a great father, a loving grandfather, and a great husband.
